



Kent State University's Team Competition Camp (June 12th–15th)

"A Competitive, Exciting And Affordable Camp Experience"

Competition Format:

Resident Teams and Commuter teams will be split into two different divisions. The goal of the camp is for every team to get at least 10–12 Complete Dual Meet matches and to determine who are the best Resident and Commuter Teams. Resident teams and Commuter teams will compete against each other throughout the camp even though they will be in two separate divisions. Each Individual on the Resident Team and the Commuter Team that are declared champions will receive a belt! Technique Sessions will be taught by camp staff daily.

Weight Classes: 106, 117, 125, 133, 141, 148, 156, 170, 194, and Hwt.

**Camp director has option to add/adjust weight classes after weigh ins to compensate number of participants that may be bottle necked in a particular weight area. For example, a 210 weight class will be added if needed.*

Housing:

All wrestlers will be housed inside the Kent State Field House, the same location as the camp. Each team will have own sleeping area blocked off by dividers on the turf. Lockers will be available for valuables in the Locker Room area. (Wrestlers will be able to hang out with teammates and coaches nightly which will promote team bonding) We encourage bringing tents and making it a true Camping Camp!

Supervision:

Our camp staff of coaches and college wrestlers will supervise campers at all times. Wrestlers will not be allowed to leave Field House area without permission. Lights out/bed time will be at 11:30 p.m. nightly. Our staff will be able to keep a better eye on campers since they will be in one area and not in separate floors and rooms in the dorm.

Meals:

Meals will be catered and held in the Varsity K Room, which is under the Football Stadium. Resident Campers receive three meals daily, while commuters receive lunch and dinner daily.

Nightly Activities: (9:30 p.m.-11:30 p.m.)

Each night the staff will set up activities for the campers. Example Activities include nightly wrestling movies on huge screen, Corn hole tournament, and poker tournament for KSU Gear! One night we will have a pizza party for campers. This camp is designed to be competitive and also enjoyable at the same time!

Awards:

May the best team WIN the Custom Robe! Each member of the championship team will receive a belt for their effort. Belts will be given to best Resident team and Commuter team! Awards for 2nd place teams and most pins will also be given.

Pricing:

Our prices are hundreds less than any other college team camp. Bring 18 or more wrestlers and it's even a better deal! If you are close enough to commute, this camp is a no-brainer. (Compare to Ohio State: \$440 and Michigan: \$425)

Resident: \$275/\$250 (18 wrestlers plus rate) **Commuter:** \$135/\$120 (18 wrestlers plus rate)
