KENT STATE WRESTLING CAMP DETAILS

All Campers are placed into groups of similar skill in order to ensure the most improvement, challenge and fun during their camp experience.

SUPERVISION

Campers will be supervised by the coaching staff and counselors at all times.

HOUSING

All wrestlers will be housed inside the Kent State Field House. Lockers will be available for valuables in the Locker Room area. Wrestlers will be able to hang out with teammates and coaches nightly which will promote team bonding.

NIGHTLY ACTIVITIES (9:30PM-11:30PM)

Each night the staff will set up activities for the resident campers. These camps are designed to be beneficial and also enjoyable at the same time.

MEALS

All meals will be provided for resident campers. Commuters will receive lunch and dinner.

FIRST AID PROVIDERS

There will be a first aid provider on duty at all camp sessions.

INSURANCE

Primary coverage is the responsibility of each camper and his parent(s)/guardian(s). KSU has purchased secondary insurance for each participant that will cover over and above the participant's primary coverage. You will need to download and print off the medical release form and return it by the first day of camp.

CHECK-IN INFORMATION

Check-in for campers will occur at the Field House on the first day of camp. (Except Youth Camp) Check-in will be from 12pm-2pm. You will receive a confirmation e-mail with all check-in and session information. Session times for each camp can be found on our camp website as well.
